- Nominee's statement of educational/teaching philosophy (not to exceed two pages).
- Description and evidence of teaching method and assessment of student learning (not to exceed 15 pages).
- Summary of student evaluations in courses taught over the past five years (include copies of official statistical summaries for all courses taught and evaluated AND prepare a one- to two-page summary table listing the means for each official university evaluation question for each course taught and evaluated, noting course number, title or abbreviated title, and semester and year; do NOT include individual student response sheets and do not go beyond the past five years).

Documents prepared by the nominee must use size 12 point Times font (or similar). Incomplete packages will be returned without consideration. Packets become the property of the Bagley College of Engineering and may be displayed within the college.

If selected as a member of the Bagley Academy of Distinguished Teachers, I understand that the college will work with me to submit a packet for consideration for the Grisham Master Teacher award (if appropriate).
