Under the Partnership the student will

1. Apply to UIR by the appropriate deadline.
2. Attend orientation for the Partnership Program at UIR.
3. Apply as a transient student at Mississippi State University and enroll at UIR in a Diploma of Engineering degree program. A high school transcript should be sent along with the partnership application. Student must meet MSU transfer admission requirements upon the completion of their 3rd year at UIR.
4. Each semester/term ensure the Support Institution provides the Home Institution with a Support Institution academic transcript upon completion of the semester/term.
5. By virtue of signing the partnership document, the Registrar at UIR and the Registrar at MSU are authorized to verify enrollment and forward a transcript between the two institutions.
6. Maintain satisfactory academic progress as published in the policy of the Home Institution.
7. To remain eligible, student must maintain enrollment in 6 or more hours.
8. Enroll in courses as prescribed by the desired Partnership program of study outline as certified by his or her Home Institution advisor and satisfy minimum grade point requirements as specified by the degree program.
9. Pay tuition, fees, and other expenses as charged by Université Internationale de Rabat.
