## **Engineering Statistics I**

Engineering Statistics I in Rome is a unique opportunity to spend one month in Italy with other Mississippi State University students and learn how the principles of probability and statistics are applied in a modern and historical global context. MSU students will reside in comfortable and modern facilities at the University of Rome, Tor Vergata campus. Besides numerous adventures in the Eternal City of Rome, the group will travel to Pompei, climb Mount Vesuvius, and spend a few nights in Florence. Students will also have an option to travel for a few days on their own to the destination of their choice.

- Open to all engineering students.
- Non-engineering students can apply with instructor's consent.
- Course is taught in English by MSU faculty.
- Prereqs: MA 1723.
- Out-of-state students pay in-state tuition.
- Program cost includes lodging, application fees, health insurance, group tours, admission fees, and some other activities, including a weekend trip to Florence.
- Tuition, travel to/from Italy, any personal travel, local transportation and most meals are not included.
- This course satisfies the Overseas requirement for the Global Engineering Leadership (GENL) minor.
