Bagley College of Engineering Graduation Requirements

PURPOSE

The purpose of this Engineering Operating Policy and Procedure (EOP) is to define the additional requirements to graduate with a Bachelor of Science degree from the Bagley College of Engineering.

REVIEW

This EOP will be reviewed every four years (or whenever circumstances require an earlier review) by the Bagley College of Engineering Administrative Council with recommendation for revision presented to the Dean.

POLICY/PROCEDURE

To graduate with a baccalaureate degree from the Bagley College of Engineering, in addition to meeting the requirements as specified in the Mississippi State University [Academic Operating Policy 12.11](#), candidates must have earned at least a 2.00 cumulative grade point average on all courses scheduled and rescheduled (average on all attempts) at Mississippi State University that are applied toward meeting degree requirements. Departments within the Bagley College of Engineering may have requirements in addition to those specified in this policy.
