



Downloading and Viewing Class Videos

Step 1

- 1) Navigate to the following URL: <https://oc-engage.engr.msstate.edu/engage/ui/index.html>
- 2) Fill in your NetID and NetPassword.
- 3) Click **LOGIN**.
- 4) Authenticate with **DUO**.

Step 2

- 1) The page displayed will contain a list of videos that can be accessed (all distance courses you are currently enrolled in). If the list is too long for one page, the **Previous** and **Next** buttons at the bottom of the page can be used for navigation. The page will auto populate if you continue scrolling downwards.
- 2) The **Series** tab at the top can be used to categorize different classes if you are enrolled in more than one course.
- 3) The search field can also be used to find a specific recording.


Step 3

- 1) Click on the video you wish to view and/or download.




Step 4

- 1) The video will now be displayed and begin playing.



Step 5

- 1) There are several ways to customize the video layout. Please see the blue icons that are highlighted when your mouse cursor is moved onto the playing video.



Step 6

- 1) At the bottom right of the media player there are several options to change certain aspects about the player. There 6 options in particular that are useful.



This icon brings up the menu to search through the transcription of the audio.

This icon brings up the menu to access the Downloads and Video quality submenus.

This icon brings up the menu to quickly change the video layout.


This icon brings up the slide selection/segmentation menu.

This icon will enable the captions to be displayed at the bottom of the video.

This icon will full screen the video.

Step 7

- 1) Once the **Downloads** submenu is selected, it displays 6-8 separate files. Each recording consists of two individual video files – one for the presenter and one for the podium content. If created, there is also a composite download of both inputs combined together. Again, there are 3 different resolutions that can be downloaded for each video.
- 2) To download your desired resolution or file, you only have to click the orange text to begin the download. The video will open in your computer's default video player once selected from the browser or file manager.
